

The regular meeting of the Village of Arcade (VOA) Board of Trustees, Wyoming County, New York was held on Tuesday, November 5, 2013 at 7:00 pm there were:

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

Mayor May opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**ZONING**

Zoning Officer Lexer discussed the topic of having chickens as pets within the Village limits. Per the current zoning law the only area where chickens are allowed is in the agriculture district. The question arose if the Village should pursue this would the governing regulations be a local law a section of the zoning law? Lexer feels this is a zoning issue. He raised the question "If we address chickens, should we also address other animals?" The only option currently would be for an individual to apply through the zoning board for a variance. At this time it was determined the zoning law will stand as is and an individual interested in having chickens will have to apply for a variance.

Lexer shared information regarding the new caboose that is located down by the Little Red Caboose Restaurant. The caboose is owned by the Friends of the Railroad, it was originally owned by the A&A. The group has spent years repairing and upgrading the caboose. Due to its historical value it was felt the location was appropriate due to the Little Red Caboose restaurant at the sight. This caboose is not permanently mounted, there will not be a fee charged to view it nor will items be sold from this caboose. Lexer will inspect the caboose in the spring to be sure the caboose meets safety measures.

Lexer is still waiting for information from Art Buckley, Wyoming County, regarding any proposed changes to the duties of the Village Zoning Officer.

The construction of the fence on North Street has begun and should be completed in the next couple of days.

Zoning Officer Lexer discussed the regulations pertaining to off sight advertising. Several people have asked Lexer to approach the board regarding this law and possible exceptions/changes to the law. Mayor May suggested those interested should apply for a variance. The board agreed.

**2012-13 TAX WARRANT ADJUSTMENT RESOLUTION**

**RESOLUTION**

Resolution authorizing an adjustment to the 2013 Tax Warrant

**TAX WARRANT ADJUSTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, Clerk/Treasurer Kraft has determined that an adjustment needs to be made to the original 2013 tax warrant signed May 15, 2013 as it was overstated by \$1,134.45, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Arcade (VOA) entered into a 10-year, non-exclusive franchise agreement with Parnassos Communications, d/b/a Time Warner Cable in August 2003, and;

**WHEREAS**, as compensation for the franchise granted, Time Warner Cable pays the VOA three percent (3%) of its Gross Annual Revenues derived from operation of the Cable System within the franchise area, and;

**WHEREAS**, according to NYS Real Property Tax Law §626(1), the amount paid as a franchise fee is to be deducted from the taxes levied on a special franchise, and;

**WHEREAS**, the VOA received a franchise payment from Time Warner Cable on March 5, 2013 in the amount of \$12,564.02, and;

**WHEREAS**, a tax was levied for Time Warner Cable and included in the original 2013 tax warrant in the amount of \$1,134.45, and ;

**WHEREAS**, based on the information above and upon the recommendation of Clerk/Treasurer Kraft, the 2013 tax warrant be adjusted to reflect a reduction of \$1,134.45,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the VOA Board of Trustees hereby authorizes Clerk/Treasurer Kraft to amend the 2013 tax warrant of \$1,257,781 by \$1,134.45. An adjusted warrant is as follows:
