**LICENSE PLATE READER**

The license plate reader the police department uses is about 6-7 years old and it no longer functions reliably. Chief Biscaro has researched the cost of a new license plate reader with a trade in. The installation was originally \$1,900 but he has found another vendor that could install it for approximately \$500. The total quote, including installation is \$13,100. The Chief will verify the warranty will still be valid even if another company installed the equipment. This equipment reads plates and reviews DMV files for unregistered vehicles, stolen cars, it also checks the identity of the owner for criminal charges that are outstanding. The Chief feels this is an extremely valuable tool.

**DRUG TAKE BACK PROGRAM**

The police department will be working in conjunction with the Wyoming County Sheriff's Office, which is partnering with DEA, on a drug take back day. The program is scheduled for Saturday, September 26, 2015, 10:00 am – 2:00 pm and will be in the parking lot of the Village of Arcade Police Department.
