

# CHAPTER 22

## FIREARMS

### ***SECTION 22-1. DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS PROHIBITED***

The discharge by any person of a shotgun, rifle, pistol, revolver, air gun, spring gun, gas gun, long bows, cross bows or other dangerous device, weapon or firearms within the corporate limits of the Village, otherwise than in self-defense or in the discharge of official duty, is hereby prohibited, and the Village area is hereby determined to be a public place within the meaning of Section 265.35 of the Penal Law.

### ***SECTION 22-2. POLICE USE***

Nothing herein contained shall prevent or limit any authorized police officer from using a firearm, tear gas, mace, or other weapon or chemical capable of force or deadly physical force within the Village.

### ***SECTION 22-3. PENALTIES***

Any person, business or corporation who violates this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable of a penalty of not less than one-hundred (\$100.00) dollars nor more than two-hundred (\$200.00) for each violation.
