SECTION 23-1. AUTHORITY.

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the provisions and authority of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, and shall be known as the Games of Chance Law of the Village of Arcade, New York.

SECTION 23-2. DEFINITION

The words and terms used in this Local Law shall have the same meaning as such words and terms are used in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 23-3. GAMES OF CHANCE AUTHORIZED; RESTRICTIONS

Games of Chance may be conducted in the Village of Arcade, New York by an authorized organization, after obtaining a license therefore, in accordance with the provisions, requirements and limitations of Article 9-A of General Municipal Law, the rules and regulations of the New York State Racing and wagering Board and this Local Law.

The conduct of Games of Chance on Sundays is authorized, except as otherwise restricted in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law.

SECTION 23-4. ENFORCEMENT

The Powers and Duties as set forth in Sub-division 1 of Section 194 of the General Municipal Law shall be exercised by the Chief Law Enforcement Officer of the Village of Arcade, New York.

SECTION 23-5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State after approval thereof by the voters of the Village of Arcade, New York voting thereon at an

election to be held pursuant to the provisions of Section 188 of the General Municipal Law.

SECTION 23-6. PARTIAL INVALIDITY

If any part of this Local Law is found to be held unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective, in whole or in part, such determination shall not be deemed to affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof.
